Contemporary politics has made no stranger bedfellows than Marxism and the New Left. Nor has it produced a more provocative interrogation of theory by practice and practice by theory. *The Marxian Legacy* examines the causes, history and lessons of this interrogation and, since its first publication in 1977, has become acknowledged as a model of trenchant analysis.

The challenge that has emerged is to reunite philosophical rigour and practical efficiency. Dick Howard suggests that this reconciliation requires us to recognise that Marx himself was insufficiently radical and that a 'new ontology' is necessary if theory is not to end in sterility and practice in a new totalitarianism.

Through detailed analysis of Luxemburg, Bloch, Horkheimer, Sartre, Habermas, Merleau-Ponty, Lefort and Castoriadis, Howard delimits the nature of Marxism, its adequacy to its own theoretical and practical project and its appropriateness to our own situation today.

Working from within the Marxian legacy, Dick Howard poses its problems across the fields of philosophy, sociology, political science and history. With these disciplines becoming forced more and more to interrogate their own foundations, this major new edition of a standard work (its substantial new Afterword ranging across the arguments of the past decade) could not come at a more opportune time.

**Dick Howard** is Professor of Philosophy at the State University of New York at Stony Brook. Among his previous publications are *The Development of the Marxian Dialectic*, *From Marx to Kant*, *Selected Political Writings of Rosa Luxemburg*, *The Unknown Dimension*, *European Marxism since Lenin* and *La naissance de la pensée politique américaine*.
